Description: Henry Ford Hospital/Wayne State University offers a 3 year ACGME accredited FPMRS fellowship beginning in July 1, 2013. There is a 3 year OB/GYN tract and a 2 year Urology tract. Henry Ford Health System is a tertiary care center. The fellowship program encompasses two hospitals – the main campus in downtown Detroit and a suburban West Bloomfield campus. Fellows' ambulatory and surgical experiences are located at both sites. The fellowship offers an excellent opportunity to be trained for a career in academic FPMRS. There is a close and longstanding clinical, teaching, and research collaboration between the urogynecology faculty and the Urology faculty. The core faculty includes 3 fellowship trained, board certified FPMRS urogynecologist and 1 fellowship trained, board certified FPMRS urologist.
