Program Description:

The Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery Fellowship (FPMRS) at Atrium Health is a three-year program approved by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). The fellowship program is designed to train physicians to be skilled surgeons, leaders and academicians in this subspecialty field of women's health care. Fellows receive training in complex and diverse surgeries, urogynecology clinics, and clinical research in pelvic floor disorders. The home-base for the fellowship program is the Women's Center for Pelvic Health – an integrated subspecialty office with core faculty board certified in FPMRS from both urology and obstetrics gynecology. The Women's Center for Pelvic Health has three Charlotte area locations with fellows currently working clinically and operating at 2 of the 3 locations. Fellows receive excellent surgical training in laparoscopic, robotic, vaginal, and abdominal approaches. Additional training opportunities include a neurourology, gastroenterology and minimally invasive gyn/chronic pelvic pain rotations.

While in the program fellows train with various attendings and provide care at several facilities. Additionally, fellows lead and provide care for two clinics – *Fellows Clinic and Fellows Post-Operative Clinic*.
