**Description:** This program is a 2 year ACGME approved Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery Fellowship for graduates of urology residency programs. One fellow is accepted per year. The first and second years are 50 / 50 clinical and research (basic science and clinical). We have 6 fellowship trained urologists and one urogynecologist. There is extensive clinical experience and surgical volume in female pelvic floor disorders including urinary incontinence, urodynamic testing, pelvic prolapse, interstitial cystitis / painful bladder syndrome, neurourology, neuromodulation, vaginal prolapse repair with native tissue and mesh, robotic surgery, fistula, mesh complications, and urinary diversion
