Description: Our three year Fellowship Program in Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery has been training fellows since 1982. Fellows will receive diverse training in treating pelvic floor disorders with extensive training in laparoscopic, robotic, vaginal, and abdominal surgical approaches to treating prolapse and incontinence. Teaching also includes rotations with members of our pelvic floor center: urology, colorectal and GI. Diagnostic techniques used to evaluate pelvic floor disorders include single and multichannel urodynamics, cystourethroscopy, endoanal ultrasound, manometry and radiographic studies. This fellowship provides a basis for an academic career while affording a strong clinical exposure to all aspects of Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery.
