Description: The primary goal of this ACGME accredited Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery (FPMRS) Fellowship Program at Houston Methodist Hospital is to provide fellows with advanced training in both the diagnosis and the medical and surgical treatment of pelvic floor disorders while improving health care and quality of life in women. These disorders include urinary incontinence, voiding dysfunction, overactive bladder, pelvic organ prolapse, and childbirth related injuries to the pelvic floor. We offer an intensive and comprehensive clinical research experience in related aspects of Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery.

At Houston Methodist Hospital, we have the infrastructure and multi-disciplinary collaboration to provide excellent urogynecologic training. We collaborate and work closely with the Department of Urology and our fellows will spend a large proportion of their time with female urologist and neuro-urologists. We have a robust pelvic floor physical therapy program and a state of the art Methodist Health Research Institute.

The FPMRS Fellowship Program participates in the Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS). Applicants complete the standard application in ERAS; in addition, applicants are asked to email their CREOG scores to the Program Coordinator as part of the application process. FPMRS Fellow positions are filled through the National Residency Matching Program (NRMP) match.
