Program Description: Our three-year FPMRS program aims to train fellows to become leaders and experts in women's health and female pelvic medicine and reconstructive surgery (FPMRS) while pursuing a rigorous academic career. The clinical and research training experience is enriched by utilizing the multidisciplinary expertise of urology, colorectal surgery, gastroenterology, gerontology, psychiatry, physical therapy, neurology, as well as plastic surgery working with the Center for Pelvic Floor Disorders and with Transgender Health Program. The program also emphasizes the development of clinician scientists who will develop and implement relevant and important basic science, translational, and clinical research in the field of female pelvic medicine and reconstructive surgery. Fellows spend one year in a basic science research laboratory at the Vincent Center for Reproductive Biology.

Other Degrees or Curricula Offered: Additional training, including a completion of the Summer Program in Clinical Effectiveness, may be available on a case-by-case basis. We anticipate that the rigorous academic and research curriculum provided within the fellowship will enable the fellow to pursue an academic career in basic, translational or clinical research.

Requirements: Graduate of accredited US or Canadian residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology or Urology Program

Length: 3 years for Ob/Gyn and Urology applicants

- Subsequent interview offers may then be extended to candidates who are waitlisted or submitted applications after January 18th
