Program Offer: a 3 year fellowship for gynecologists. The program is ACGME compliant and accredited. Each fellowship includes 12 months of dedicated research. With 24 months of clinical rotation in Urogynecology and Urology. The Fellowship faculty includes four Urogynecologists and one Urologist. Fellows are trained in the evaluation and treatment of women with all pelvic floor disorders. Both surgical and nonsurgical approaches to treatment are emphasized. Surgery includes vaginal, abdominal, laparoscopic and robotic approaches. Fellows are also prepared for academic careers via full participation in research projects, grant development, presentation at national meetings, and journal publications.
