It provides comprehensive, multi-disciplinary training in female urology, pelvic floor reconstruction (vaginal, open, laparoscopic and robotic) and sexual dysfunction, as well as exposure to neurourology, neuromodulation, urinary diversion and urodynamics. Male incontinence, erectile dysfunction, and prosthetic surgery opportunities are also available outside of the female pelvic medicine curriculum.
