The program is truly one of the few training programs in the USA where reconstructive urology and gynecology is completely integrated into one division that spans two departments. Fellows in our program become proficient in all modes of surgery including open, robotic, and transvaginal approaches. There are clinical rotations in FPHRS, Urology, Colorectal/Gastroenterology, and Geriatrics which all serve a large and diverse patient population.
