

Committee Charter

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f i	The Philanthropy and Development Committee serves the Society by ensuring that AUGS' fundraising and development efforts are in concert with the Society's strategic direction and financial needs. The committee serves as the mechanism by which members are nvolved in the fundraising process. The committee undertakes the following activities:
Committee Activities / Committee	 Work with staff to develop a realistic fundraising/development campaign that outlines measurable goals and desired outcomes
Charges & Strategies	 Oversee the development of strategies for generating revenue and fundraising and periodically evaluating the effectiveness of these strategies Play a strong role in identifying, cultivating, and approaching major donors (this includes individual, foundations and corporate) Make recommendations regarding Board giving targets
	 Provide recommendations on donor outreach and donor recognition programs Perform such other duties and responsibilities as the Board may determine from time to time
Roles and Responsibilities	 Run an effective meeting to ensure involvement of committee members and the advancement of activities and charges Deliver the Committee's recommendations to the Board via written reports and/or communication with the Board liaison
	 Vice Chair Support the Committee Chair to ensure responsibilities are met in a timely manner. Serve as interim Committee Chair in the absence of the Chair. Ascend to the position of Chair.
	• Be prepared and actively participate in all conference calls and meetings
Committee A Relationships	The Philanthropy and Development Committee also engages, as needed, with other AUGS Committees to assist with the implementation of these charges. These committees may include the Finance Committee, Grants Committee, DEI Committee, Awards Committee, and/or Patient Education Committee.
Commitment r	The committee meets every other month, as needed, via conference call. Committee members are expected to review all agenda/materials prior to each meeting and attend the conference calls as scheduled.

Committee	All committee members serve a one (1) year term and are eligible for reappointment for
Terms	up to two additional consecutive terms (up to three years of service). Terms run January
	1 – December 31. The Committee Chair and Vice Chair will each serve a two-year term.
	The Vice Chair should ascend to the role of Chair upon completion of their term as Vice
	Chair.
Selection/	Members are appointed by the AUGS Governance Committee with input from the
