## **Executive Committee Committee Charter**



Purpose	The Executive Committee acts on behalf of the Board of Directors between meetings, guided by the Board's known positions. In urgent situations where the Board's stance is unclear, it may make timely decisions. The Committee also serves as the Board's personnel committee, conducting the CEO's annual performance review with input from the full Board.
Ongoing	The committee undertakes the following activities:

	Hire, suppor, and conduct performance evaluations of the CEO.
